Our School Vision:

“Mighty Oaks from Tiny Acorns Grow”

Our Vision is based upon the parable of the mustard seed: “The kingdom of God is like a mustard seed, that seed is the smallest of all seeds. But when it grows, it is one of the largest garden plants” [Matthew 13 V31-32] This is underpinned by the common language of our core values: Hope, Forgiveness and Justice.

In the event of a school closure, or if individual pupils need to work from home for a period of time, our children from Years 1-6 will access school work from home via Google Classroom. Google Classroom is a safe and secure solution for children to access learning materials directly from their class teachers. Every child has a unique login to access Google Classroom. Teachers will be able to upload lessons, objectives, and a variety of resources to support learning at home.

If pupils are unwell, they are not expected to complete remote learning for that day.

Covid 19

Our current guidance is that if children test positive for Covid19, they will be asked to be absent from school for 3 full days or until they are feeling better. Test day is day zero. In this event, the class teacher will upload work daily to Google Classroom for pupils to complete, should they feel well enough to complete it. Completed work can then be uploaded for the class teacher to mark and provide relevant feedback.

Live lessons

Should the whole school be closed for a period of time, pupils will be able to access their normal daily timetable via live zoom lessons or pre-recorded sessions. If individual pupils are absent, they will be able to access either a pre-recorded session or set work from Google Classroom.

Tapestry

Reception Parents will be able to access their children’s work from home via Tapestry. Our Early Years staff will contact parents directly and all classwork will be uploaded onto Tapestry. An appropriate amount of work will be sent, this will be no more than 2 hours due to the structure of the children’s school day. Daily Phonics and Maths sessions will be included in this.

Homework

As a school, we are now using Google Classroom to enable all of our pupils to access weekly homework. This includes any Spelling, Literacy, Mathematics, and Topic Homework set. Completed homework can be submitted via Google Classroom or a hard copy handed into the teacher.
